Type of competition:	Inclusive Skating – a brief guide It's a 'Blue Riband' sport of the Winter Olympic Games – but ice skating has never been accepted into the Winter Paralympics or held a World Championship – yet! We are getting closer. There are now World Rankings for Inclusive Skating and the Glasgow 2017 event is piloting the system for the first World Championships.
	The Inclusive Skating competition system includes skaters with any form of disability and allows skaters who are disabled and able bodied to skate together in the same competitions on an equal basis through an impairment compensation that is added to the skater's skating score.
	In many respects the system mirrors that of a golf handicap, which allows golfers with hugely differing abilities to compete on an equal basis. All skaters, coaches and officials should feel rightly proud to be a part of this momentous event – you are the pioneers of what we hope and believe will become a worldwide programme, perhaps leading eventually to ice skating being accepted as a full Paralympic sport.
	We are delighted that this event will also include the very first Inclusive Skating for Genes British Championships. This event will provide an event that provides opportunities for children with genetic disorders who are particularly disadvantaged by other classification systems in disability sport.
